

## **Report to FTC meeting on Wednesday 11th August 2021**

### **RNLI EMERGENCY CALL OUT CREW PARKING**

I am please to inform the Council that I personally have arranged for the 4 parking spaces adjacent to the Water Pumping station to be designated with immediate effect for the use only of RNLI crews on call outs. These spaces are not to be used by RNLI or shop staff.

Temporary measures are currently in place but they will be marked permanently in the near future.

I note from Cllr Cockerill's report that it appeared to be his idea with myself and Sam Cross as footnotes.

I can assure you that I contacted Cllr Tony Randerson (Portfolio Holder) and Jane Wilson, SBC Parking Services Manager on 31st July after a request from the RNLI. I

was then contacted by Jane Wilson on 2nd August to say it had been agreed.

Cllr's Cross and Cockerill were merely copied into my original e mail for their support, which they gave.

## **FILEY INITIATIVE**

I am please to report that as a member of this group things appear to be happening at last. I won't go into detail as I see this is an Agenda item on tonight's meeting so you will find out all that has happened then.

## **FILEY TOWN MAP AND GUIDE COMMITTEE**

Having been a member of this group for a good number of years when it was still a Working party and now as a member of the group again I was dismayed to see that their was a wish that FTC considered charging for the Guide. I was happy to see at their last meeting dated 3rd August that this was narrowly defeated.

I feel the need to and make no apologies for putting this in my report because the Guide and Map mean a lot to me personally and I could only see serious issues ahead if charging had been agreed.

Why change something that is not broken, the Guide group have consistently been in profit with the Guide and map always paying for themselves, notwithstanding the issue a year or three back when an emergency printing of 10,000 more Guides had to be done thereby causing an overspend.

I genuinely hope that FTC will not find the need to re-visit this matter again.
