	<p>The Committee requested the Clerk to arrange a “Teams” meeting with MK to discuss the issues and associated costs and improvements for next year.</p> <p>FTC to review the Christmas tree brackets in line with the previous brackets used.</p> <p>The Committee also agreed for the repair of the wall where the bracket came away.</p> <p>The Committee also agreed to the payment of the costs of £30.16 to be paid to the Imperial Pub for supply of electricity.</p> <p>Christmas trees- The trees on the roundabouts were considered to be very good and it was agreed that any extensions and new lights/bulbs be purchased where required.</p> <p>The Clerk to look into the addition of a tree adjacent to the White lodge.</p>
<b>EL13/20/21</b>	<p><b>Future events</b></p> <p>The Committee resolved not to plan any events for the next year due to the Covid restrictions but requested an amount of money be continued to be allocated for events in the budget in the hope that these some events would occur. Future events could be a celebration of the Queens jubilee in 2022, celebration of 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the opening of Memorial Gardens.</p>
