	<p>Cllr Cockerill proposed, seconded by Cllr Cronk that in accordance with section 1 (2) of the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960 members of the press and public be excluded from the meeting as the following item gave details of personal information which the Council had not been given permission to share with the public.</p> <p><b>RESOLVED: Council unanimously resolved that the press and public be excluded from the meeting.</b></p>
77/21/22	<p><b>Appointment of Honorary Freeman/Freewoman of Filey</b> Members were informed that five nominations (Candidates A – E) had been received and confidential nomination forms for each candidate had been previously circulated for the individual consideration of each candidate to ascertain whether they met the criteria for this award.</p> <p>Members felt that candidate B did not meet the criteria and so this application did not warrant further consideration. It was considered that all the other candidates met the minimum requirements.</p> <p>The selection process was discussed following which voting took place. Only one candidate achieved sufficient votes to gain selection.</p>
77/21/22.1	<p><b>RESOLVED: That candidate D be awarded the title of Honorary Freeman/Freewoman of Filey. It was agreed that the award presentation should take place prior to the next Council meeting to be held on the 8<sup>th</sup> of September 2021.</b></p>
77/21/22.2	<p>Although Candidate B had not met the criteria to be considered for appointment of Honorary Freeman/Freewoman of Filey, their voluntary work in a particular area over a number of years was considered to have been exceptional and so Cllr Cockerill proposed, seconded by Councillor Crawford-Gage that Candidate B be presented with an achievement certificate. A vote followed.</p> <p><b>RESOLVED: That candidate B be presented with a Certificate of Achievement.</b></p>
