The report gave details of crimes, road related incidents and anti-social behaviour between 1 April 2021 and 30th September 2021.</p> <p>As there wasn't a representative from North Yorkshire Police available to attend this evening's meeting, Members were asked to send any questions they may have on the report via the Town Clerk.</p>
121/21/22	<p>Mayoral Report</p> <p>The Mayor reported that recently she had attended the 100-year concert of the RBL, Remembrance Service and Ceremony, opened a new shop and attended the awards night at the Ebor Academy. FTC have contributed as promised £20,000 to the FFAS. A reception was planned to acknowledge the event, but the Council was informed that this was to be re-considered due to the enhanced COVID restrictions. The mayor also reported that a meeting had taken place regarding the transfer of Assets and Services this was very fruitful meeting. SBC were given an outline of the priority items, the Evron centre, Glen and Crescent gardens, the caravan and Camping site and the Beach Kiosks. But before any decisions which would be made by Full council considerable additional information was requested which SBC promised to be made available very soon in the New Year.</p> <p>The Mayor also commented that SBC were looking to use some of the money from the sale of the "Conference Centre" for use in Filey. The Town Plan is being worked upon with some of the quick fixes being completed such as the refurbishment of the Gate pillars at Glen Gardens.</p> <p>The Mayor also informed the meeting that it was probable that a Council election would take place in May of 2022.</p> <p>The Mayor went on to announce the death of Julie Viles an ex- Filey Town Councillor and Deputy Mayor this was followed by a minute's silence to honour her.</p> <p>Finally, the Mayor explained the procedure for the use of Facebook.</p>
