	<p>It was requested that the Clerk contact SBC legal department (Carol Rehill) to attend a meeting as soon as possible to discuss the matter.</p>
<b>PR07/21/22</b>	<p><b>Parish Wood</b> The Committee reviewed the remedial action plan from FBOG and decided to review the progress during the year. The Clerk was also requested to inform FBOG of the difficulties in closing the area and the need to seek permission for any tree felling.</p>
<b>PR08/21/22</b>	<p><b>Bonzo the Seal</b> The Committee requested that the Clerk contact Roger Burnett and give approval to the remedial work suggested but to possibly include oak sawdust in the sealant. Also, that care and attention be taken to ensure that the sealant be fully cured prior to the statue returning to its location and that when re-installed it should be done so on blocks to prohibit the rotting of the plinth.</p>
