105/20/21	2021-2022 Budget Following a review of the Budget document it was proposed by Cllr Haxby and seconded by Cllr Wilkie to approve the budget with a precept remaining at £161,500 although this will increase the Band "D" equivalent Council tax by 2.53% due to the reduction of band "D" equivalent properties in the Town. This was voted on and passed unanimously.

	Resolution: - The Council resolved to approve the budget as proposed.
106/20/21	Grants The Council reviewed the proposal for the awarding of grants made by the Finance and General Purposes Committee it was proposed by Cllr Haxby and seconded by Cllr Robinson and the grant proposal be accepted. This was voted on and passed unanimously. Resolution: - The council resolved to accept the recommendation made by the Finance and General Purposes Committee.
107/20/21	Lawns Cemetery Fees The Council discussed in detail the proposal made by the Finance and General Purposes Committee. The followings are the proposals arising from those discussions. It was proposed by Cllr Houlden-Banks that the costs for Adults graves etc. be raised by 10% only. This was seconded by Cllr Robinson. This was voted on and passed by a majority of 7 votes to 4.
107/20/21.1	Resolution: - The Council resolved to increase the charges for Adult graves etc. by 10%. (no increases were to be made to child grave costs.) It was proposed by Cllr Cockerill and seconded by Cllr Robinson that an additional administration fee of £25 be added for the work required to administer the ejection of memorials.
107/20/21.2	Resolution: - The Council resolved to add a charge of £25 for the administration of memorial ejection. As there would be a change in the budgeted income due to the resolutions above it was proposed by Cllr Haxby and seconded by Cllr Wilkie to allow the budget to be changed by the revised figure and the effected Precept to be increased likewise. This was voted on and passed by a majority of 6 votes to 5 votes.
107/20/21.3	Resolution: - The Council resolved to allow the budget to be changed by the revised figure and the effected Precept to be increased likewise.
