

MONTHLY STATEMENT from MJC of SBC matters relating to Filey

Coble Landing Parking

The restrictions on the car parking spaces directly opposite the kiosks on Coble Landing had remained in place following the relaxation of 19th July.

I had requested this to reduce the potential conflict between vehicles and pedestrians in this very busy area.

Since then, following support from all 3 Borough Councillors, the decision has been taken to designate these spaces for RNLI crew members attending "a shout".

This does not include any day to day use by RNLI staff or volunteers.

Filey Flood Alleviation Scheme

Regrettably the contractors have not completed all of the work that remains to be finished. Consequently the site has not been taken back by the Borough Council so remains a construction site.

Memorial Gardens

Whilst I am pleased that the Borough Council has offered the freehold of Memorial Gardens to the Town Council, I believed that the initial SBC offer was not equitable to both parties.

I put forward a suggestion to Borough officers that, in my opinion, would be more equitable.

I understood the stance of SBC that the work necessary to maintain the area was insufficient to allow SBC to add any financial consideration to the offer but I did and still do believe that a Cost Neutral offer could be made.


I contacted the relevant officers and suggested that a Service Level Agreement (SLA) should be offered to the Town Council.

My suggestion being that the SLA would mean that SBC would continue undertaking the same routine work as at present, i.e. with no additional cost to either Council.

Any additional work, maintenance or capital, would not be funded by SBC.

Unfortunately, as we heard at the Filey Town Plan meeting, SBC officers have concerns in regard to an SLA. However, it has been suggested that £3,000 per annum for 2 years could be paid by SBC to FTC.
