


MONTHLY STATEMENT from MJC of SBC matters relating to Filey

Filey Flood Alleviation Scheme (FFAS) & Environmental Enhancements

Due to COVID the low key event to commemorate the practical completion of the FFAS and to recognise the contribution of many people and agencies will be delayed.

Yorkshire Coast Destination Business Improvement Bid (YCBID).

During a presentation to the Places and Future Overview & Scrutiny Committee by YCBID work to create various Trails was mentioned.



I informed the meeting that the Town Council were to consider the creation of a Lighting Trail and a Sculpture trail through Filey. I was informed that these could be included in the work of YCBID if the Town Council so wished.

YCBID is also considering identifying and publicising Walking Trails.

During the meeting the feedback and involvement of the public to the recent survey in regard to the needs of Filey was applauded.

I suggested that the use of non Local Authority personnel was an important factor in this success.

SBC Officers indicated that this would be a beneficial way forward in other areas of the Borough.

It was also confirmed that an amount of funding had been allocated to the application from the Town Council towards enhanced Christmas Lighting for 2022. YCBID were only awaiting further information to allow this to progress.

Wheelchair & Disable Access to Flood Alleviation Footpaths

At the moment I do not have a timescale for this work to be carried out.

SBC Assets & Services

Newly Resurfaced Footpath by the side of St Oswald's Churchyard

The refurbished footpath running along the top of the Northern bank of Church Ravine and down Glacier has received complementary comments.

Coastal Path

The surface Coastal Path that runs alongside the golf course is, in my opinion, a vast improvement. Not only has the path been surfaced with tarmac planings but steps have been created leading up from the stream at Primrose Valley.

However, part of the access path from near the entrance to Filey Golf Club to the newly surfaced bath is a mud bath. This is considered to have been, at least in part, caused by the contractor's plant using this route to access the cliff path.

I have been promised that the situation will be monitored and consideration given to undertaking repair work if felt necessary.



I have forwarded the enclosed images that, in my opinion, clearly show that, as this path is used throughout the year, repair work is required when conditions permit.
