Last week we inspected Glen Gardens as part of the Green Flag Award preparation process and I noted that the graffiti wall constructed behind the MUGA is in a very poor state with paint and render dropping off onto the surrounding ground. It has been in a poor state for quite a few years now and the graffiti has spread onto the adjacent MUGA, youth shelter and climbing blocks.

The wall at very least requires re-rendering but it may be more sensible to remove it altogether as it is no longer being managed by PCSO Tony Bate who arranged its original installation and it is causing a wider maintenance problem .

Does Filey Town Council have a view on the most appropriate course of action in this respect?
